## Champagne

1. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir*, NV. £49.50  
12.5%. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.
2. Gosset Grande Reserve, *Chardonnay- Pinot Noir-Pinot Meunier* £88.00  
NV. 12%. Intense and complex. Aromatic notes mixed with flowers and fruits. A long and powerful flavour.

### Rosé

3. Gosset Grande Rosé Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir*, NV. 12%. £94.00  
A fresh, lively and delicate flavour. An ideal balance between Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

## Sparkling

4. Camel Valley 'Cornwall' Brut 2014, *Seyval Blanc-Huxelrebe-Reichensteiner*. Nanstallon, Bodmin. 12.5%. A quintessential English sparkler, produced just ten miles away at Camel Valley vineyards near Bodmin. Bright and lively whilst still remaining elegantly fruity.

### Rosé

5. Camel Valley Pinot Noir Rosé Brut, 2015, *Pinot Noir*. 12.5%. £57.00  
A taut, creamy pink, Cornish Pinot Noir from Camel Valley. Fragrant with restrained cranberry fruit.

## Prosecco

6. Mionetto Prosecco Di Valdobbiadene DOC "Spago" NV. 11% £34.00  
Sublime style from one of the leading houses. An elegant aperitif.

# White Wine

## France

### Languedoc

7. Domaine St. Félix, *Sauvignon-Vermentino*, 2017, Languedoc. £23.50  
*12.5%*. Our house white wine. Fresh and aromatic this is a very easy drinking white with delicate fruit and a bright finish.

8. Domaine St. Hilaire, *Viognier*, 2017, Costières de Pomerols. £32.75  
*13.5%*. A medium, full bodied wine. Aromas of ripe apricots and peaches. Flavours of melon and pear.

### Alsace

9. Domaine Henry Fuchs, *Gewürztraminer*, 2015, Ribeauvillé. £35.00  
*13.5%*. Sweet and aromatic with exotic fruit. Lovely mouthfeel with good acidity and honey on the palate. Hints of Earl Grey and lychee on the nose.

### The Loire Valley

10. Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine sur Lie, *Melon de Bourgogne*, £26.50  
2017, Domaine de la Tourlaudière. *12%*. Exquisitely balanced with subtle apple-like aromas, a hint of citrus and finishing with a Muscadet tingle. A great partner with seafood.

11. Pouilly Fumé, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2017, Domaine Nicolas Gaudry £39.50  
*12.5%*. A zesty, honeyed nose, with delicate, floral notes. Dry, with good tension and intense, long flavours.

12. Sancerre, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2014, Roger and Didier Raimbault, £47.00  
Verdigny. *12.5%*. A beautifully balanced wine, bringing together ripe apples and citrus with fragrant acidity. There is a sense of minerality in the texture, with depth of flavour finishing with lively acidity.

### Burgundy

13. Rully Premier Cru, *Chardonnay*, 2014, Domaine Jacques Dury £45.00  
*13%*. This almondly flavoured white is delicate and lively, yet has developed rich and subtle aromas of brioche which finishes with nuances of buttery oak. The real attraction is the perfect balance, which makes for a silky mouth feel.

14. Meursault, *Chardonnay*, 2017, Domaine Vaudoisey-Creusefond, £68.50  
Cote de Beaune. *13.5%*. Dry with a firm acidity, the aromas are flinty, with hint of almonds, citrus fruits a may flowers. In its youth still, this wine will be at its best with fish dishes.

## Cornwall

15. Camel Valley Bacchus Dry, *Bacchus*, 2016, Nanstallon, Bodmin £39.50  
12%. A fresh, dry wine with a deliciously fruity bouquet and grapey flavour.
16. Knightor *Madeleine Angevine*, 2016, Trethurgy, St. Austell. £39.50  
12%. A very elegant wine with subtle gooseberry, nettle and elderflower aromas.  
The palate is fine and restrained with gentle acidity and good balance.

## Italy

17. Ornato Terre Siciliane, *Pinot Grigio*, 2017, Vicenza. 12% £24.25  
Classic Italian Pinot Grigio. Dry with refreshing and balanced acidity. Perfect with any fish dish.
18. Gavi di Gavi, *Cortese*, 2016, Sarotto, Piedmont. 12.5% £38.50  
The Cortese grape produces fine, racy dry wines in the Piedmont region of Northern Italy. Restrained, and minerally with aromas of fresh bread, lime and toasted almond.

## Spain

19. Rioja Blanco, *Viura-Malvasia*, 2017, Muga, Rioja Alta. 13% £34.60  
This white rioja is traditionally straw-yellow/green in colour. The nose is powerful with aromas of pineapple and peach. The palate is fresh with well-integrated oak, pungent spicy flavours and good acidity.
20. Godello Crego e Monaguillo, *Godello-Treixadura*, 2017, 13% £41.00  
A complex, dry wine which definitely rivals Albariño. Aromas of orange blossom and apples followed by an intense and beautifully balanced palate of tropical fruit with a touch of lime.

## Portugal

21. 'Raza' Quinta da Raza, *Arinto-Azal*, 2017, Vinho Verde. 11.5% £24.50  
A classic Vinho Verde, with some gentle spritz. Very pale, lemon-green, with a nose of white flowers and citrus. On the palate clean, crisp, refreshing, with orchard fruit flavours. A lovely summer wine.

## Germany

22. Dr Loosen Estate, *Riesling*, 2015, Mosel. 8.5% £34.50

Fresh, lively wine with well-balanced fruit, flavours of pears, apples and peach with a touch of spice and attractive underlying minerality.

## Hungary

23. *Grüner Veltliner*, Torley Talisman, 2016, Tokay. 11.5% £26.00

From vineyards of Ethel-Buda, Torley is an innovative wine yard at the forefront of Hungarian wine making. Clean and dry with flavours of fresh pears.

## South Africa

24. Lyngrove, *Chenin Blanc*, 2018, Lutzville. 13% £26.00

Western Cape. A classic South African Chenin Blanc – a grape they've made virtually their own. Succulent, a touch off-dry, with gentle honeyed orchard fruits and mineral finish.

25. Mulderbosch, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2017, Stellenbosch. 13.5% £37.00

A great pioneer for quality South African Sauvignon that gives New Zealand a run for its money. Plenty of ripe fruit underpinned with crisp nettle, herbaceous notes.

## New Zealand

26. Lanark Lane, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2017, Marlborough. 12.5% £36.00

Fresh, lively gooseberry and passion fruit aromas on the nose. The palate is rich and concentrated with a beautiful, balanced finish.

## Australia

27. Auction House, *Chardonnay*, 2015, SE Australia. 12.5% £26.00

With the move away from big oaky chardonnays this light breezy white is succulent, buttery fruit with a lemony edge.

# Rosé Wine

## Cornwall

28. Trevibban Mill Black Ewe Rosé, *Pinot Noir-Dornfelder* £37.95  
2017, Padstow. 11% (Organic) A refreshing, crisp rosé which presents salmon pink in the glass with aromas of wild red berries. On the palate, flavours of tart cherry, red currant, blood orange and grapefruit.

## France

29. Domaine St Félix, *Grenache-Cinsault*, 2017, Languedoc. 12.5% £23.50  
Our house rosé wine. Almost Provencal in style, delicate, salmon pink and heather dry.
30. Gamali, *Grenache-Cinsault*, 2016, Domaine la Goujonne, £33.00  
Côtes de Provence. 13% (Organic)  
Delicious nose of red, summer fruits with a hint of zesty grapefruit. Soft and fruity but with good supporting acidity and flavour intensity, with a hint of fig.

## Spain

31. Borsao Rosado, *Garnacha*, 2017, Campo de Borja. 13.5% £24.00  
Strawberry pink in colour, crisp and packed with ripe, red fruits. Easy drinking in style showcasing more fruit flavours than the paler style roses'.

# Red Wine

## France

### Languedoc

32. Domaine St. Félix, *Merlot-Cabernet-Carignan*, 2016, £23.50  
Languedoc. 12.5%. Our house red wine. Soft and smooth with juicy blackberry fruit and silky tannins on the finish.

### Bordeaux

33. Château Tour Bigorre, *Cabernet Sauvignon-Cabernet Franc-Merlot*, 2009, Côtes de Bordeaux Castillon. 14%. A family estate passed from father to son for more than two centuries. A dark, inky wine. Dusty, earthy notes in the beginning with red fruits and some tannin. £36.00
34. Château Bellisle Mondotte, St Emillion Grand Cru, £72.00  
*Merlot-Cabernet Franc*, 2008, *Libournais*. 13.5%  
Aromas of dried plums, currants, cedar, tobacco and dried herbs. A medium bodied wine, driven by freshness with soft, silky and slightly savoury tannins.

### Burgundy

35. Beaune, *Pinot Noir*, 2015, Domaine Yves Girardin £44.00  
Cote de Beaune. 13%. Penetrating aromas of soft red fruits. The tannins are well-integrated into the fruit and extract, giving excellent balance.
36. Santenay 1<sup>er</sup> Cru, *Pinot Noir*, 2015, Château de la Charrière, £52.00  
Cote de Beaune. 13%. A nicely spicy and gently wood-inflected Santenay 1er Cru, with an appealing range of spiced red berry fruit.

### Provence

37. Bandol, *Mourvèdre-Grenache*, 2005, Domaine Le Galantin. £38.50  
13.5%. This is a medium-bodied, complex wine, with aromas of spice, pepper and leather, but still with fresh fruit notes, such as raspberry and blackcurrant.

### Beaujolais

38. Beaujolais-Villages, *Gamay*, 2015, Domaine de la Rizolier. 12.5%. £33.00  
Appetising aromas of redcurrant and cherry, with succulent fruity flavours from an exceptionally concentrated year.

### Côtes du Rhône Villages

39. Sablet, *Grenache-Syrah*, 2016, Domaine Notre Dame des £34.50  
Pallieres. 14.5%. Beautiful bright purple colour, with a nose of fresh, intense fruit and notes of Morello cherry and blackberry. The palate is fleshy, crunchy, full of fruit with weight and silky tannins.

## Italy

40. Baglio Gibellina, *Nero D'avola - Frapatto*, 2016, Sicily. 13.5%      £28.00  
Bright intense red fruit on the nose displaying lots of red berries. Warm and full bodied on the palate, with balanced acidity and smooth, elegant tannins.
41. Valpolicella Superiore, *Corvina-Rondinella-Sangiovese*,      £45.00  
2016, Veneto. 13.5%. A beautifully smooth and velvety wine with great depth of flavour. The nose offers supple fragrances of almonds and violets. Crisp, dry and well-structured in the mouth.

## Spain

42. Clos Mont Blanc, *Tempranillo-Cabernet Sauvignon*, 2016,      £26.00  
Conca de Barbera, Catalonia. 14.5%. Intense ruby red colour. Aromas of red fruits, raspberries and blackberries, and balsamic notes. The taste is sweet, elegant mix of fruit and toasted wood.
43. Rioja Crianza Lopez, *Tempranillo-Garnacha Tinta-Graciano*,      £34.50  
2015, Bodegas Classica, Rioja Alta. 13.5%. Soft, expressive and elegant, combining subtle toasty vanilla notes with perfectly balanced oak.

## Portugal

44. Terra D'Alter, *Aragonés (Tempranillo)*, 2014, Alentejo. 14.5%.      £34.50  
Strong dark red centre with a purple edge. Rich blackberry and wild strawberry flavours with strong tannins resulting in a long, spicy finish.

## Lebanon

45. Massaya Le Colombier, *Cinsault-Cabernet Sauvignon-Syrah*.      £37.00  
2015, Bekaa Valley. 14.5%. A dark rich, plummy nose, perfumed and aromatic with the sweetness of eastern spice. Great body, well-rounded, a splash of acidity and crunch red fruits from the Cinsault

## South Africa

46. Freedom Cross, *Pinotage*, 2017, Franschoek Cellars. 14%      £26.00  
Western Cape. A softly styled pinotage with intense blackberry fruit and mocha coffee notes.
47. Meerlust Rubicon, *Cabernet Sauvignon-Merlot-Cabernet Franc -Petit Verdot*, 2014, Stellenbosch. 14%. Meerlust's Rubicon is one of the most highly rated wines in South Africa. This Bordeaux blend has a rich, intense spicy nose with a tarry edge. Concentrated, firmly tannic palate with spicy tannins and good acidity.

## New Zealand

48. Felton Road, *Pinot Noir*, 2015, Bannockburn, Central Otago. £63.00  
14%. Subtle layers of dark berry flavours and sweet spices here. Elegant, refreshing and balanced. A great food wine.

## Australia

49. Whistling Duck, *Shiraz*, 2017, New South Wales. 13.5% £26.00  
A beautifully concentrated wine. Rich flavours of ripe plums, dark cherries and fresh blackberries with a lovely hint of spice.
50. Botham Merrill Willis, 2011, *Cabernet Sauvignon*, £46.50  
Coonawarra. 14.5%. Cricket legends and fellow wine buffs Ian Botham and Bob Willis joined forces with one of Australia's top wine makers, Geoff Merrill, to launch their own range of fine wines. Deep red in colour with intense aromas. The palate is wonderfully supple and fleshy with fine firm tannins providing excellent structure.

## Chile

51. Cornellana, *Merlot*, 2017, Cachapoal Valley. 13.5% £26.50  
A brilliant Merlot from an area that is producing some of the best Chilean wines. A deep red wine with classic Merlot characteristics; soft with concentrated ripe fruit in particular cherries plums and blackberries.
52. Casas del Bosque, *Syrah*, 2015, Casablanca. 14.5% £43.00  
A full bodied wine. A perfect New World expression of the "Shiraz" grape – blackberry, black olive and lifted black pepper spice. Soft and creamy texture with fine vanilla oak.

## Argentina

53. Gouguenheim, 2016, *Malbec*, Mendoza. 13% £35.50  
Aromas of black raspberry and currants with a hint of toasty vanilla. This full-bodied, well-structured wine has plenty of fine, velvety tannins to carry the long finish.

# Half Bottles

## Champagne

54. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir*, NV. £32.50  
*12.5%*. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.
55. Gosset Excellence Brut NV, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir- Pinot Meunier*, Champagne. £48.00  
Fresh pear, honeysuckle and vine flower aromas, slightly influenced by Pinot Noir. A balanced wine and a good flavour.

## White

### France

56. Pouilly-Fumé , Sauvignon Blanc, 2015, Domaine Michel Bailly, £24.00  
The Loire Valley, *13%*. Aromatic and complex Sauvignon, with exotic fruits, and flavours of quince and pear, with a spicy note of ginger too.

### New Zealand

57. Kim Crawford, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2017, Marlborough. *12.5%* £22.50  
Benchmark Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc from this iconic producer. A mouth watering slab of crushed gooseberry and pineapple flavours.

## Red

### France

58. Bourgueil, *Cabernet Franc*, 2010, Domaine de la Chanteleuserie £23.00  
The Loire Valley, *12.5%*. Flavours of black cherry, raspberry, roasted herbs and signature green bell pepper on the palate. The finish is pleasant and lengthy.

### Lebanon

59. Chateau Musar, *Cabernet Sauvignon, Cardigan, Cinsault*, £34.00  
2010, Bekaa Valley, *13.5%*. Deep, rich garnet colour with aromas of raisins, cedar and prunes. An elegant vintage with fresh acidity and a long, dry finish.

# Dessert Wines

## France

60. Muscat de Beaumes de Venise, 2014, **Bottle (750ml)** £52.00  
Domaine de Bernadins, Vaucluse. **Glass (75ml)** £5.95  
*15%* Copper/orange in colour with a ripe, grapey aromas with a twist of orange blossom and hint of spice. Rich in the mouth, soft and silky with a touch of honey.

## Australia

61. Vat 5 Botrytis, *Sémillon*, 2013, **Half Bottle (375ml)** £28.50  
De Bortoli Riverina. *11%* **Glass (75ml)** £6.95  
The baby brother of The Noble One. A beautifully honeyed dessert wine with a refreshing vein of citrus.

62. Noble One, Botrytis *Sémillon*, 2014, **Half Bottle (375ml)** £54.00  
De Bortoli, Riverina. *10%*  
Australia's benchmark dessert wine. First created by Darren De Bortoli at the family winery in Bilbul in 1982, Noble One has gone on to be one of the most awarded wines in history. Bright yellow-gold, aromas of nectarine and peach with citrus hints and sweet vanillin oak. A richly opulent palate of dried stone fruits, citrus and honey complexed by oak.

## California

63. Elysium, *Black Muscat*, 2015, Madera **Half Bottle (375ml)** £35.00  
*15%* Deep ruby red in colour this black **Glass (75ml)** £8.95  
muscat is exquisitely syrupy with brambly aroma and wild sweetness. Great with chocolate.

## South Africa

64. Late Picked Noble Riesling 2017, **Half Bottle (375ml)** £39.50  
Paul Cluver Estate, Elgin **Glass (75ml)** £9.95  
*11%* Paul Cluver's Noble Riesling is the best of its kind in South Africa and easily one of the finest in the new world. Dried apricot, spices and honey characters on the nose. The mouth feel is full and big and very balanced with a long lingering aftertaste.
