

Champagne

- 1. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut / Chardonnay-Pinot Noir-Pinot £72.00 Meunier / NV / Maurice Delabaye et Fils /12.5% / Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.
- 2. Gosset Grande Réserve / Chardonnay- Pinot Noir-Pinot Meunier £100.00 NV /12% / The tiny bubbles and biscuity aroma of this wonderfully smooth champagne make it iconic. It has a beautiful light gold colour, sweet aromas of nuts and pears, with a remarkable finish.

Rosé

3. Gosset Grande Rosé Brut / *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir* / NV / 12% £120.00 Delicate salmon pink in colour with rich red fruits on the palate. A superb finish on account of the lively acidity.

Sparkling

- 4. Prosecco Spumante Porte Nova / *Glera* / NV / Veneto / *11%* £38.00 Pale light yellow in colour with a delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. On the palate hints of honey and apple.
- 5. Camel Valley Cornwall Brut / Seyval Blanc-Pinot Blanc-Chardonnay / 2021 / Cornwall / 12.5% / A fresh and fruity traditional method sparkling wine from Camel Valley.

Rosé

6. La Guilloterie / Cabernet Franc / NV / Crémant de Loire /France £48.00 12.5% / An exceptional pink crémant. Peachy pink colour, sweet notes of red fruits and bread crust on the nose. Creamy, fruity and soft in the mouth.

White Wine

Cornwall

 Atlantic Dry / Pinot Blanc-Bacchus / 2022 / Camel Valley / £45.00 Bodmin / Cornwall / 12.5%. Delicate aromas of grapefruit, elderflower and green fruit. Bright lemon in colour, with a very fresh, clean finish.

France

- 8. Domaine St. Félix / Sauvignon-Rolle / 2022 / Pays d'Hérault / £30.00 Languedoc-Roussillon / 12.5% / Our house white wine. Fresh and aromatic this is a very easy drinking white with delicate fruit and a bright finish.
- 9. Cicada / Grenahe Blanc-Viognier-Picpoul / 2022 / Domaine £32.50 Chante Cigale /13% / Made using stainless steel tanks; fruit driven with apricot and juicy melon flavours, accented with floral notes and lemony acidity.
- 10. Domaine Henry Fuchs / *Gewürztraminer* /2019 /Ribeauvillé. £45.00 Alsace / 13.5% / Hints of Earl Grey and lychee on the nose. Off-dry and aromatic with exotic fruit. Lovely mouthfeel with good acidity and honey on the palate.
- 11. Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine sur Lie / Melon de Bourgogne, / £35.00 2022 / Domaine des Raillères / The Loire Valley / 12% / White floral and citrus aromas, with flavours of fresh pear, green apple and fine minerality. A great partner with seafood.
- 12. Sancerre / Sauvignon Blanc / 2022 / Domaine Tassin, £56.00 The Loire Valley / 13% / Unoaked, the palate is rich in fruit flavours and finishes with the right balance of texture and refreshing acidity.
- 13. Aligoté / 2022 / Domaine Jacques Dury / Côte Chalonnaise / £44.00 Burgundy / 12.5%. / This Aligoté is all about freshness, minerality and tension. The aftertaste focuses on the beautiful acidity and salty texture.
- 14. Chablis / 'Les Senties' / *Chardonnay* / 2020 / Famille Ternynch / £65.00 Burgundy / 13%. / Aromas of fresh flowers and citrus. Clean, crisp and elegant, with white fruit and mineral flavours.
- 15. Meursault / *Chardonnay* / 2018 / Domaine Paul Garaudet / £95.00 Côte de Beaune / Burgundy / 13% / A truly remarkable Meursault. Full of rich layers of buttery fruit, underlying mineral roundness and texture with an amazingly long persistent finish.

Germany

- 16. Dr Loosen 'L' / *Riesling* / 2021 / Mosel / 8.5%. £36.00 Fresh, lively wine with well-balanced fruit, flavours of pears, apples and peach with a touch of spice and attractive underlying minerality.
- 17. Oliver Zeter Fumé / Sauvignon Blanc / 2021 / Pfalz /13%. £68.00 A full, expressive Sauvignon Blan, fermented in oak barrels to deliver a smoky "fumé" element. Mouthwatering stone fruit, lemon, herbs, a hint of passion fruit and subtle notes of gooseberry.

Italy

- 18. Mont 'Albano / *Pinot Grigio* / 2022 / Friuli / 12.5% 237.00 Notes of pear and white flowers with citrus vibrancy. Excellent depth of flavour with a clean, crisp finish.
- 19. Gavi di Gavi / La Giustiniana / Cortese / 2022 / Piedmont / 13% £55.00 The Cortese grape produces fine, racy dry wines in the Piedmont region of Northern Italy. Restrained, and minerally with aromas of fresh bread, lime and toasted almond.

Spain

20. Piqueras / Verdejo-Sauvignon Blanc /2022 / Almansa £32.00 12.5% / Fresh and crisp on the palate, with flavours of citrus and tropical fruits. A long, persistent finish.

Portugal

21. Semente / Alvarinho / 2022 / Vinho Verde / 13% £45.00 Intense aromas on the nose of citrus fruits, nectarines and honeysuckle. The palate is vibrant, showing a refreshing acidity with ripe flavours of fleshy white peach, lime and a subtle saline note on the finish.

Greece

22. Little Ark / Assyrtiko-Malagouzia / 2022 / Peloponnese / 13% £47.00 Brilliant straw colour with greenish shades. Notes of melon and jasmine with orange on the nose. The mouth is rich with flavours of peach, green apple and a lemony fresh finish

Hungary

23. MÁD / Furmint / 2018 / Tokaji / 12%. £52.00 Elegant, delicately aromatic with a touch of spice. Apricot, lychee, honeysuckle and ginger. Well-balanced with minerality and structure. Bright, mouthwatering acidity.

South Africa

- 24. Jordan 'Inspector Peringuey'/ *Chenin Blanc* / 2022 / £45.00 Stellenbosch / 13.5% / A richly textured Chenin Blanc that has been aged on-lees for 8 months in French oak. Pretty florals on the nose, with delicious citrus, quince, tropical fruits and a creamy honeyed, spice driven finish.
- 25. Babylonstoren Candide / Chenin Blanc-Viognier-Chardonnay-Sémillon / 2021 / Simonsberg / Stellenbosch / 13.5% / This intriguing white blend expresses a fresh, fruit-driven wine with peach, lime and litchi flavours. Light and refreshing, yet complex.

New Zealand

26. Green-Lip / Sauvignon Blanc / 2022 / Jackson Estate / £50.00 Marlborough / 13% / Named after the native New Zealand green-lip mussel, the wine demonstrates tropical fruit flavours, balanced with fine minerality, followed by an expressive finish. Jackson Estate is a neighbour to Cloudy Bay vineyards.

Australia

- 27. Whistling Duck / *Chardonnay* / 2022 / New South Wales / *12.5%* £33.50 With the move away from big oaky chardonnays this light breezy white is succulent, buttery fruit with a lemony edge.
- 28. Wild and Wilder / 'The Courtisan' / *Riesling* / 2021 / One Chain / £40.00 Clare Valley / 12% / Extravagantly perfumed nose and beautiful frame corseted by mouthwatering fruit. A lime citrus tang with grapefruit and quince followed by a long dry finish.

Lebanon

29. Massaya / Classic White / Obeïdi.-Rolle-Clairette-Sauvignon Blanc- £53.00 Chardonnay / 2021 / Bekaa Valley / 13% / White flower, lemon, and a touch of nectarine. It combines depth, roundness, crispness, and an oriental twinkle thanks to the local obeïdi.

Rosé Wine

Cornwall

30. Camel Valley / Pinot Noir / 2022 / Bodmin / Cornwall /12% £45.00 Fresh, delicate and fruity, with aromas of raspberry and strawberry. A beautifully balanced wine.

France

- 31. Domaine St Félix / *Grenache-Cinsault* / 2021 / Languedoc-Roussillon / 12.5% / Our house rosé wine. Almost Provencal in style, delicate, salmon pink and heather dry.
- 32. Gamali / *Grenache-Cinsault* / 2022 / Domaine la Goujonne / £44.00 Côtes de Provence / 13.5% Delicious nose of red, summer fruits with a hint of zesty grapefruit. Soft and fruity but with good supporting acidity and flavour intensity, with a hint of fig.

Spain

33. Mesta / *Tempranillo* / 2022 / Central Castile / 11.5% Strawberry pink in colour with fruity, floral flavours. Slightly off-dry finish balanced by a crisp acidity and a refreshing, savoury note.

Lebanon

34. Château Musar / Jeune Rosé / *Mourvèdre-Cinsault* / 2021 / £46.50 Bekaa Valley / 11.5% / Wonderful fruit aromas of pomegranate, rhubarb, pink grapefruit and hints of rosewater. There are strawberry, peach and pomegranate fruits on the palate which is nicely textured with fine, crisp acidity and freshness on the finish.

Red Wine

France

- 35. Domaine St. Félix / *Merlot-Cabernet-Carignan* / 2020 / £30.00 Pays d'Hérault / Languedoc-Roussillon / 12.5% / Our house red wine. Soft and smooth with juicy blackberry fruit and silky tannins on the finish.
- 36. Château Grand Tayac / 2019 / Cabernet Sauvignon -*Merlot*- *Petit Verdot / Alain Roses / Margaux / Bordeaux / 13% /* Ripe blackberry, plum, black cherry and spices on the nose. Strong tannins, medium to full body and black fruits, tobacco and vanilla on the palate.
- 37. Pommard / Pinot Noir / 2005 / Chateau de la Charriere / £105.00
 Domaine Yves Girardin / Côte de Beaune / Burgundy /13.5% / From the extraordinary vintage of 2005, this Pommard retains the firmish tannins typical of the appellation, as well as the freshness and red fruit flavours that Pinot Noir is known for. A delicate touch of oak gives added depth.
- 38. Beaujolais-Villages / Gamay / 2022 / Domaine de la Rizolière / £38.50 13% / Appetising aromas of redcurrant and cherry, with succulent fruity flavours. A light bodied red, suitable with white meat and fish.
- 39. Sablet / *Grenache-Syrah* / 2021 / Domaine Notre Dame des £43.00 Pallières / Côtes du Rhône Villages /14% / Beautiful bright purple colour, with a nose of fresh, intense fruit and notes of Morello cherry and blackberry. The palate is fleshy, crunchy, full of fruit with weight and silky tannins.
- 40. Domaine Huber & Bléger / *Pinot Noir* / 2021 / Rouge de Saint-Hippolyte / Alsace /13.5% / With an appetising aroma of soft, red fruits, this Alsace red is light but full of flavour. The tannins are fine-textured and it has delicious, clean Pinot Noir flavours.
- 41. Domaine de la Roche Honneur / *Cabernet Franc* / 2022 / Chinon / £45.00 Loire /12.5% / An unoaked Chinon with youthful, wild-berry fruit, herbal notes, chalky tannins and a refreshing Cabernet Franc tang on the long finish

Italy

42. U...Passimiento / Nero d'Avola – Frapatto / 2021 / Baglio £38.00 Gibellina / Sicily / 13.5% / Bright intense red fruit on the nose displaying lots of red berries. Warm and full bodied on the palate, with balanced acidity and smooth, elegant tannins.

Italy cont.

43. Zenato Valpolicella Superiore / *Corvina-Rondinella-Sangiovese* / £58.00 2020 / Veneto / 13.5% / A beautifully smooth and velvety wine with great depth of flavour. The nose offers supple fragrances of almonds and violets. Flavours of black cherry and prune.

Spain

- 44. Torres Vinyarets / Sumoll- Garnacha Tinta-Tempranillo / 2021 / £42.00 Penedès / Catalonia / 13.5% / Aged 10 months in oak barrels. Bright ruby red in the glass, the nose is full of raspberry and cherry with floral hints. The palate is delicate rather than powerful, with velvety tannins and a long finish.
- 45. Rioja Crianza / Lopez de Haro / *Tempranillo-Garnacha Tinta-*£43.00 *Graciano* / 2020 / Rioja Alta / 13.5% / Soft, expressive and elegant, combining subtle toasty vanilla notes with perfectly balanced oak.

Portugal

46. Altano / Touriga Franca-Tinta Roriz-Tinta Barroca / 2020 / £36.50 Symington Family Estates / Douro Valley / 13.5% / Generous aromas of wildflowers. Full bodied structure with fresh, assertive fruit and spicy notes.

Israel

47. Har'el / *Merlot* / 2020 / Clos de Gat / Judaen Hills / *13.5%* / £62.00 Powerful aromas of blackberries & plums, which are enhanced by notes of earthy Mediterranean terroir. On the palate, the wine is rounded and full bodied, tannins smooth and already integrated with a long finish. A beautifully soft wine.

Lebanon

48. Château Musar, Cabernet Sauvignon-Carignan-Cinsault, £98.00 2017, Bekaa Valley. 14%. This is a wine constructed at a snail's pace. Each individual element is fermented and aged separately, spending its first 12 months in barrel. After three years the wine is blended and aged in the Musar cellars a further three years prior to release. Deep, rich garnet colour with aromas of raisins, cedar and prunes. An elegant vintage with fresh acidity and a long, dry finish.

South Africa

- 49. Freedom Cross / *Pinotage* / 2019 / Franschhoek Cellars / *13.5%* £35.00 Western Cape / A softly styled pinotage with intense blackberry fruit and mocha coffee notes.
- 50. Babylonstoren / Shiraz / 2019 / Simonsberg / Paarl /14% £45.00 This full-bodied wine is a fusion of cherry fruit, soft prunes and spice, with a chewy mouthfeel and juicy, lingering finish.

New Zealand

51. Greywacke / *Pinot Noir* / 2020 / Malborough / *13.5%.* £76.00 A beautifully balanced wine. Perfumed nose of cherry and wild fruits leads to a beautifully balanced palate with pure fruit, a subtle herb character and a kiss of smoky oak.

Australia

- 52. Whistling Duck / Shiraz / 2021 / New South Wales / 13.5% £33.50 Rich flavours of ripe plums, dark cherries and fresh blackberries with a lovely hint of spice.
- 53. Bird in Hand / *Cabernet Sauvignon* / 2019 / Adelaide Hills / £62.50 13.5% / This medium bodied wine is an intensely complex, yet varietal cabernet, with blackcurrant, plum and violet florals complemented by oak characters.

Chile

54. Cornellana / Cabernet-*Merlot* / 2022 / Cachapoal Valley /13.5% £33.00 A well-structured approachable red, medium bodied with plummy, curranty fruit. The Cabernet gives superb depth and structure to the fleshy Merlot. From an area that is producing some of the best Chilean wines.

Argentina

55. Altivo Classic / *Malbec* / 2022 / Mendoza / *13.5%* £37.00 Aromas of black raspberry and currants. Ripe and rounded with a plummy fruit and good balance.

USA

- 56. Edmeades / Zinfandel-Petite Syrah-Syrah / 2018 / Mendocino / £62.50 California /15.5% / Bold and intense on the palate with soft tannins and rich flavours of spice, blackberry jam, chocolate and some cedar notes.
- 57. Domaine Carneros / Avant Garde / *Pinot Noir* / 2020 / £72.00 Los Caneros / Napa Valley / 14% / A light, fresh pinot noir made in the Burgundy style. Oak aged for 8 months with flavours of vanilla, cherry, raspberry and spiced fruit.

Uruguay

58. Bodega Pablo Fallabrino / Notos / Nebbiolo-Tannat / 2020 / £46.00 13% / Medium bodied and a translucent cherry red in colour. Aromatics of dried rose petals. On the palate, raspberry leading to a silky finish laced with hints of orange peel and pepper.

Champagne

- 59. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir-* £37.50 *Pinot Meunier*. NV. 12.5%. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.
- 60. Gosset Excellence Brut NV, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir- Pinot* £50.00 *Meunier*, Champagne. Fresh pear, honeysuckle and vine flower aromas, slightly influenced by Pinot Noir. A balanced wine and a good flavour.

White

France

61. Pouilly Fumé, Sauvignon Blanc, 2021, Domaine Nicolas £27.00 Gaudry. 12.5%. A zesty, honeyed nose, with delicate, floral notes. Dry, with good tension and intense, long flavours.

Red

France

62. Brouilly, *Gamay*, 2020, Château du Pave, Brac de la Perriere. £25.00 13%. The dominant fruit on the palate is black cherry, with a touch of cassis and raspberry. A wine that finishes long.
